

Twelvemile Beach Campground

Twelvemile Beach Campground is located 15 miles west of Grand Marais on county road H-58. The campground has 36 sites on a high sandy plateau by Lake Superior. There are two disabled accessible sites. Twelvemile Beach is often full during July and August and holiday weekends. The best time to obtain a site there is mid to late morning. The campground has water, pit toilets, picnic tables, fire rings and an interpretive amphitheater. The North Country National Scenic Trail runs through the campground. There are three sets of stairs to the beach as well as a day use picnic area and parking. The two mile long self-guiding White Birch Interpretive Trail begins and ends in the east end of the campground. Because the turning radius and some parking site lengths are limited within this campground, we recommend single vehicles no more than 36 feet and vehicle/trailer combined length no more than 42 feet. Fees: Lake front sites - \$16 per night, inland sites - \$14 per night.
